


PARTICIPATORY DESIGN

We found that **integration into community** is what tends to make us feel "moved in."





WORKBENCH


A shared area where neighbours can fix, build, and learn together. Tools are available, and conversations spark naturally.

A hands-on area for guided sessions and open making.






FIKA ZONE

Provides updates on local events, workshops. Keeps visitors informed and encourages ongoing engagement with the neighbourhood garage community.






KIOSK

Agency


Increasing community interdependence, leading to a strong sense of agency.
